PRELIMS :

JUDGEMENT CRITERIA :

- Designers: Theme Originality, Depiction of Theme, Designing, Use of Props and Accessories, Use of fabrics
- Models: Ramp walk, Stage Presence, Poise, Overall Appearance
- Team: Choreography, Music and Narration, Co-ordination, Relevance to the theme, Overall Performance

FINALE :

Main Round will be held on 23rd February 2020 (4th day) from 5:00 p.m. onwards. This would be between the short-listed teams from the Preliminary round.

Time Limit: 12-15 min(empty stage to empty stage)

GENERAL RULES :

1. There can be multiple teams from a single institute.
2. Crossover teams can be formed between students of different institutes, all having valid institute ID cards for the current year.
3. Teams are required to check the website frequently for any changes in the rules and regulations and specifications of the arena of the event.
4. The teams must bring their own music system for practice. The organizing team is not responsible for providing either space or music system for practice.
5. Makeup and styling of the models are to be done by the teams themselves. We will only provide the team with a dressing room.
6. The soundtrack that the team is using should be carried by the team on a physical drive and is to be handed over to the organizing team before the event starts. This soundtrack should also be digitally sent to the organizing team 4 days prior.

7. The team can consult people outside the institute such as choreographers, make-up artists, but these professionals will not be considered to be a part of the team.
8. One member of the team should sit with a sound technician or computer operator during the performance.
9. We request to maintain the decorum of the event. Vulgarity of any kind would lead to disqualification of the team from the event. Hence, if the team feels that any stunt and/or costume design can be considered as vulgar, it is strongly advised to consult the organizers before performing it on stage. The decision of the organizers will be final in case of any disputes arising due to this.
10. No animals or birds should be harmed in making the designs. Doing so will lead to immediate disqualification.
11. Use of water, fire, pets or any hazardous materials is strictly prohibited.
12. In case of any issues, coordinators and the judge's decisions will be final and binding.
13. In case of any ambiguity, the coordinators' decisions will be final.
14. It is mandatory for every team member to carry their Institute ID card.
